# GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

## Stakeholder Forum

- 1 representative per IN (= IN coordinator)
- Total size depends on number of INs

- Provides feedback from the active implementation community
- Provides information on discipline-specific standards / solutions / needs

## Executive Board

- 7-10 IN representatives from various fields (research, infrastructure facilities, etc.)
- 1 Chair +1 Vice-Chair

- Is in charge of strategy implementation
- Has a complete overview of IN activities
- networking impulses

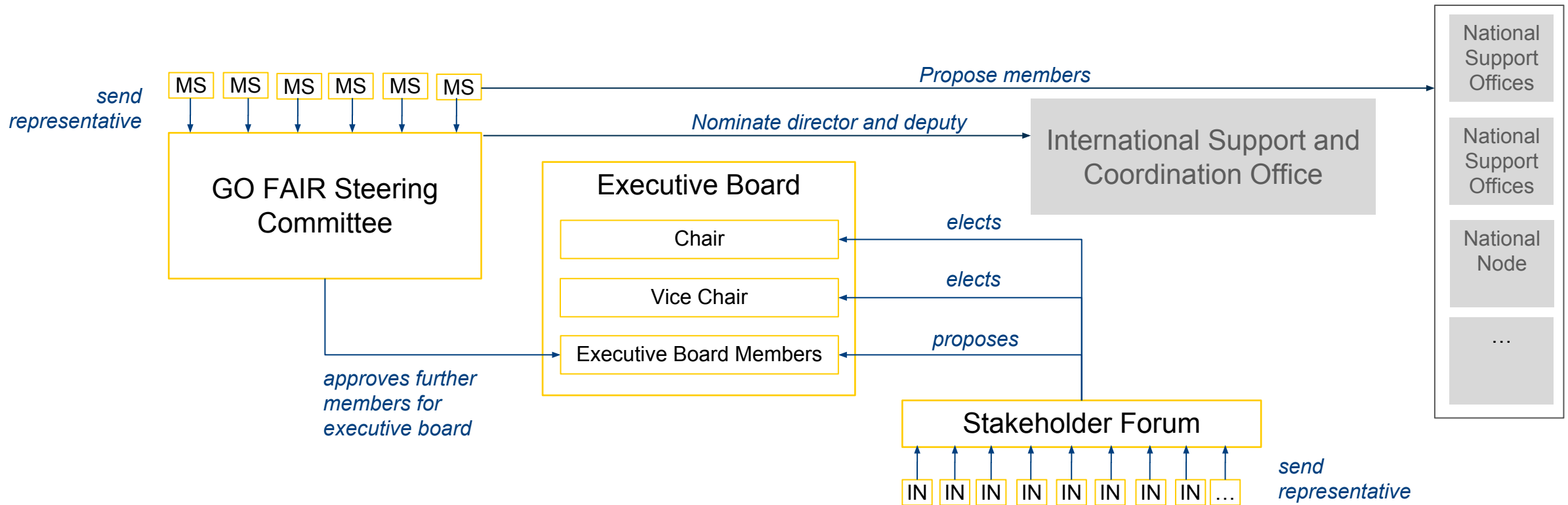
## Steering Committee

- Body of the Member States
- Each Member State is represented by 2 persons:
  - 1 research representative
  - 1 representative from ministry

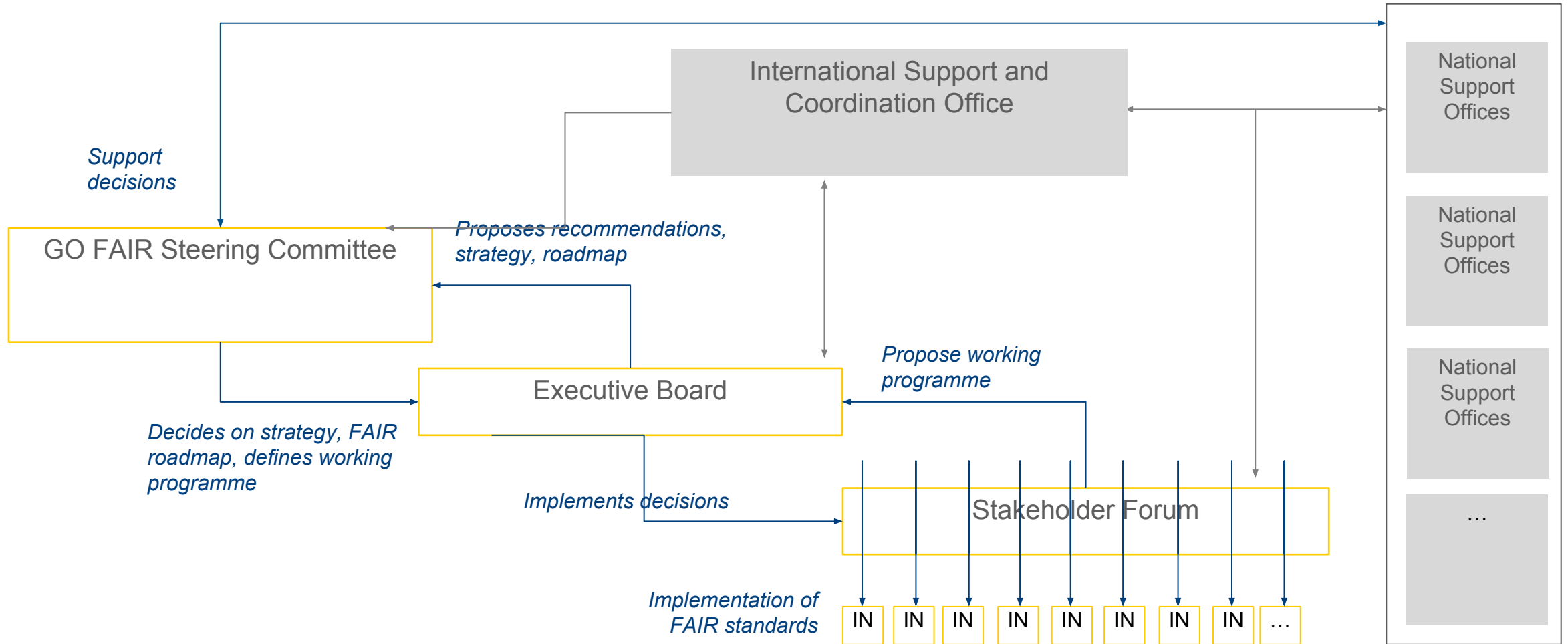
- strategic decisions for GO FAIR initiative on the basis of national coordination needs
